Non-licensed and Non-certified Psychotherapists**

Vermont law requires that persons placed on the roster of Non-licensed and Non-certified Psychotherapists to disclose to each client his or her professional qualifications and experience, those actions that constitute unprofessional conduct, and the method for filing a complaint or making a consumer inquiry. This must be done by the third visit.
